TESTING STRATEGY AND CALENDAR

Paris 2024 is responsible for planning, organising, financing, and delivering the Paris 2024 Olympic and Paralympic Games. The Paris Summer Olympic and Paralympic Games will bring together 15,000 athletes and 13 million spectators, as well as many journalists and officials. It will be the biggest event in the world, with 32 Olympic and 22 Paralympic sports watched on television by several billion viewers.

In order to provide an unforgettable experience for all clients and to enable athletes to perform in the best possible conditions, Paris 2024 has developed an Operational Readiness Programme aimed at mitigating the risks identified during the planning phase to ensure an optimal delivery of operations.

THE ACTIVITIES ARE DIVIDED INTO TWO AREAS:

- **The Testing Programme** - including the specific elements to be tested at the competition sites (schedule shown below) and non-competition sites.
- **The Readiness Programme** - including broader elements to be tested by observations or exercises in different formats (e.g. simulation, table-top exercise, on-site rehearsals, technology rehearsals).

In agreement with the IOC and the IPC, the primary objective of the Paris 2024 testing strategy is to mitigate the identified operational risks. As such, the Paris 2024 test programme is defined by a tailored approach based on the characteristics of each sport and venue and their associated risks.

On this basis, Paris 2024 has defined 3 types of testing activities:

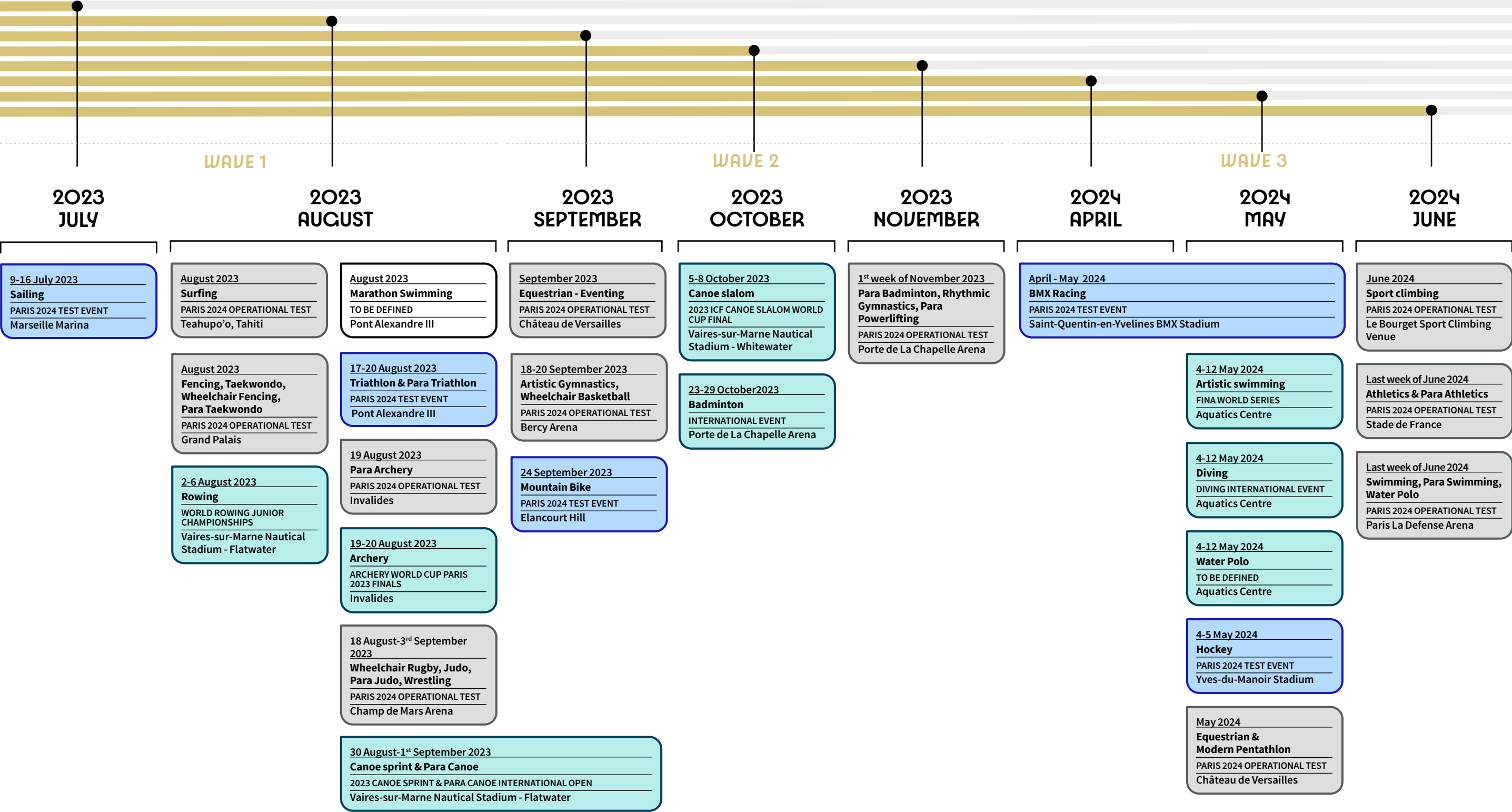
- The “**Paris 2024 Test Events**”: events for which Paris 2024 is entirely responsible for the organisation, including multiple tests during a competition.
- The “**IF/NF/third party tests**”: events organised by another entity, with which Paris 2024 will collaborate to test certain operations.
- The “**Operational tests**”: testing activities organised by Paris 2024, including specific tests behind closed doors or by invitation to a limited number of local athletes.

Sites/sports without specific testing activities will be tested as part of the Readiness programme to ensure the smooth delivery of operations. The following schedule has been designed in close cooperation with the relevant federations . It has also been developed with Paris 2024 delivery partners to replicate as much as possible the simultaneous operations of several venues by organising concurrent testing activities.

A second version of the testing calendar will be published at the end of 2022 which will include those testing activities whose details are not yet formalised.

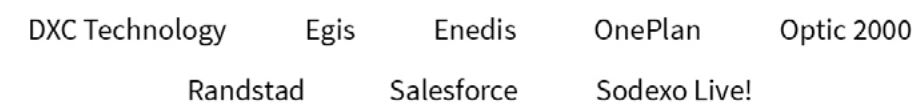
